Satsuki Palter is a first term master teacher of the Ohara School of Ikebana. She is the president of the Ohara Los Angeles Chapter and past president of Ikebana International Los Angeles Chapter.

She began studying ikebana more than 30 years ago and has performed ikebana demonstrations and exhibitions at the Getty Museum, LA County Museum, LA Arboretum, UCLA Fowler Museum, Japanese American National Museum, and Japanese American Cultural and Community Center.

She holds weekly ikebana classes near Santa Monica. She is also a certified Japanese Tea Ceremony instructor.

Non-Morton Arboretum members would pay gate fee to enter the Morton. Demonstration is free to all visitors to the Morton Arboretum.
